# Russian officer Makarevich: attacking civilians in Chechnya, then Ukraine

Oleg Leontyevich Makarevich is a colonel general of the Russian Army. In 2002, during the second Chechen war, he commanded deliberate attacks on civilians in Grozny. In 2023, he was one of those who orchestrated the invasion of the Kherson region in Ukraine and caused many civilian deaths. He has never been punished for his crimes, but they are documented in our databases.

On 3-4 November 2002, Colonel Makarevich ordered the Russian forces to shell and bomb residential buildings in Grozny (Chechnya). A pregnant woman was killed, and about 90 families were displaced. Makarevich was never prosecuted for his crimes; he was promoted to colonel general and got awards. But his crimes are documented.

In 2023, Makarevich directed aggressive operations by the Russian army in Ukraine, destroying Kherson and its surrounding areas. On 3 May, following his orders, the city was bombed indiscriminately, destroying both civilian and military objects: A shopping centre, a railway station, a gas station, and residential buildings. Makarevich is responsible for at least 24 deaths and at least 51 wounded.

On 6 June, Makarevich ordered Russian troops to destroy the Kakhovka Hydroelectric Power Plant in Kherson region. The subsequent flooding led to a large-scale humanitarian and environmental catastrophe across southern Ukraine. At least 30 people died in Ukrainian-controlled areas and dozens more in Russian-occupied regions.
